STIPULATION AND ORDER RE CHILD
CUSTODY AND THERAPY

16 WHEREAS the parties have six minor children: Maddox Jolie-Pitt, born August 5, 2001;
17 Pax Jolie-Pitt, born November 29, 2003; Zahara Jolie-Pitt, born January 8, 2005; Knox Leon
18 Jolie-Pitt, born July 12, 2008; Vivienne Marcheline Jolie-Pitt, born July 12, 2008; and Shiloh
19 Nouvel Jolie-Pitt, born May 27, 2006 (hereinafter "minor children").

20 Petitioner ANGELINA JOLIE PITT (hereinafter "Petitioner"), through her respective counsel
21 of record, Wasser, Cooperman & Mandles, P.C., by Laura A. Wasser, Esq. and Samantha Klein,
22 Esq., and Respondent WILLIAM BRADLEY PITT (hereinafter "Respondent"), through his
23 respective counsel of record, Young, Spiegel & Lee, LLP, by Lance S. Spiegel, Esq., and Buter
24 Buzard Fishbein & Royce, by Gary Fishbein, Esq., without prejudice to either party's claims or
25 contentions, hereby stipulate to the following temporary orders:

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1 1. Pending written agreement of the parties or further order of court, Petitioner shall
2 have physical custody of the minor children.

3 2. Pending written agreement of the parties or further order of court, Respondent shall
4 continue to have agreed upon therapeutic visitation with the minor children. The frequency and
5 conditions of the therapeutic visitation shall be determined by Ian Russ, Ph.D. Prior to making such
6 determination, Dr. Russ shall consult with Lisa Hacker, Judy Goldman, Angela Bissada, and
7 Catherine Green. Dr. Russ shall at all times consider the best interests of the minor children.

8 3. Pending written agreement of the parties or further order of court, Respondent shall
9 continue to participate in individual therapy a minimum of one time per week for no less than 50
10 minutes each session. At the conclusion of each month, Respondent shall provide Dr. Russ with
11 proof of his ongoing participation in individual therapy as set forth in this paragraph.

12 4. Pending written agreement of the parties or further order of court, Respondent shall
13 continue to participate in group therapy a minimum of one time per week. At the conclusion of each
14 month, Respondent shall provide Dr. Russ with proof of his ongoing participation in group therapy
15 as set forth in this paragraph.

16 5. Pending written agreement of the parties or further order of court, Respondent shall
17 continue to submit to random drug and alcohol testing as directed by Dr. Robert Waldman. The
18 random testing shall not exceed one time per week and there shall be a minimum of four tests every
19 thirty days. Within 24 hours of receipt, Dr. Waldman shall provide Dr. Russ with Respondent's test
20 results.

21 6. Pending written agreement of the parties or further order of court, the minor children
22 shall continue to participate in individual counseling. The frequency and duration of the minor
23 children's therapy shall be as recommended by Angela Bissada and Catherine Green.

24 7. Pending further order of court or written agreement of the parties, Petitioner,
25 Respondent, and the minor children shall continue to participate in conjoint sessions.

26 8. All communications by and between the parties and the mental health professionals
27 (Dr. Russ, Dr. Goldman, Lisa Hacker, Angela Bissada, and Catherine Green) shall be considered
28 "safe harbor therapy" and protected by the psychotherapist-patient privilege (Evidence Code §§

1 1012-1015).

2 9. All communications by and between the previously listed mental health professionals
3 shall also be considered "safe harbor therapy" and protected by the psychotherapist-patient privilege
4 (Evidence Code §§ 1012-1015).

5 10. **CONFIDENTIALITY**: In the interest of privacy of the parties and their minor
6 children, this Stipulation and Order is not being submitted to the Court for entry at this time.
7 Nonetheless, upon execution, this Stipulation and Order shall be effective between the parties as a
8 valid and binding agreement, whether or not it is ever entered by the Court. Either party may file
9 this Stipulation and Order with the Court as necessary to enforce any term contained herein.

10 11. This Stipulation may be executed in signed counterparts, each of which shall be
11 deemed to be an original. A facsimile and/or electronic copy of the signature pages of this

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1 Stipulation shall be deemed an original pursuant to *California Rule of Court*, Section 2.305(d) and
2 *California Civil Code*, Rule 1633.7, respectively.




