ORDER AFTER HEARING SETTING FORTH INTERIM PENDENTE LITE CUSTODY ORDERS PENDING REVIEW HEARING

Hearing Dates: May 16-17 & 21-25, 2018

Location: Alternative Resolution Center, 1875 Century Park E # 450, Los Angeles, CA 90067

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21 Petitioner's Request for Orders came regularly for hearing on May 16, 17, 21, 22, 23, 24,
22 and 25, 2018, before the Honorable John W. Ouderkirk, Judge Retired of the Los Angeles Superior
23 Court, appointed as a Temporary Judge pursuant to stipulation of the parties for all purposes
24 pursuant to the Order entered February 6, 2018. Young, Spiegel & Lee LLP, by Lance S. Spiegel,
25 and Elkins Kalt Weintraub Reuben Gartside LLP, by Anne Kiley, attorneys of record for
26 Respondent, appeared on behalf of Respondent, who was present in Court each day. Wasser
27 Cooperman & Mandles P.C., by Samantha Klein and Lisa Sutton, and Greenberg Glusker Fields
28 Claman & Machtinger LLP, by Priya Sopori, attorneys of record for Petitioner, appeared on behalf

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1 of Petitioner, who was present in Court on May 16, 2018. Having considered the evidence presented
2 and argument of counsel, THE COURT ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

3 1. The following Orders apply to the parties' five youngest minor children:

- 4 a. Pax Jolie-Pitt, DOB 11/29/2003;
5 b. Zahara Jolie-Pitt, DOB 1/08/2005;
6 c. Shiloh Jolie-Pitt, DOB 5/27/2006;
7 d. Knox Jolie Pitt, DOB 7/12/2008; and
8 e. Vivienne Jolie-Pitt, DOB 7/12/2008;

9 hereinafter collectively referred to as the Minor Children and individually referred to as the
10 Minor Child.

11 2. In the Stipulation and Order executed by the Court February 28, 2017, the parties
12 stipulated that with respect to their oldest child, Maddox Jolie-Pitt, DOB 8/5/2001, because of his
13 age and maturity, his preference shall be primary in determining his custody arrangements with
14 Respondent.

15 3. Petitioner shall forthwith arrange for a telephone call among Petitioner, the Minor
16 Children, Maddox, Dr. Jeffrey Trop and Dr. Oren Boxer which shall take place on or before May
17 31, 2018 to explain the summer schedule to the Minor Children as set forth herein and to confirm
18 the parties' mutual desire and support for the Court's Orders as set forth herein. Respondent shall
19 make arrangements for Dr. Trop to arrive in London on June 6 or 7, 2018. Petitioner shall make
20 arrangements for Dr. Trop to meet with the Petitioner, the Minor Children and Maddox on June 7
21 2018 in person to explain the summer schedule as set forth herein and to confirm the parties' mutual
22 desire and support for the Court's Orders as set forth herein. In both the telephonic and the in person
23 meetings, Petitioner shall tell the Minor Children and Maddox:

- 24 a. The Court has determined that not having a relationship with their father is
25 harmful to them;
26 b. The Court has determined that it is critical that each of them have a healthy
27 and strong relationship with their father and mother;
28 c. The Court has determined that each of them are safe with their father; and

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1 d. Each parent must strictly obey and conform to the spirit and the letter of the
2 Court's Orders.

3 4. During the period June 1, 2018 through August 10, 2018, Respondent shall have
4 physical custody of the Minor Children as follows. Petitioner shall have physical custody at all
5 other times.

6 a. Respondent shall have custody of the Minor Child(ren) he designates for four
7 hours each day from June 8, 2018 through June 17, 2018. Respondent, in his sole discretion in
8 advance, shall designate one Minor Child or two Minor Children to be with Respondent for the four
9 hour period of time each day. During this ten day period, Respondent shall spend time with each
10 child at least twice. On each day, Petitioner shall make arrangements and be responsible for the
11 drop off at Coworth Park Hotel of the Minor Child(ren) designated by Respondent to be with
12 Respondent for a four hour period of time. Respondent shall return the Minor Child(ren) or cause
13 the Minor Child(ren) to be returned to the house Petitioner is renting ("Windlesham") by the end of
14 the four hour period. Dr. Trop shall be present with the Minor Child(ren) during Respondent's time,
15 as arranged by Respondent and at Respondent's cost. Respondent shall also have the discretion to
16 have a recreational facilitator present. Petitioner shall not be present during or interfere with
17 Respondent's custodial time. Respondent shall make arrangements to have Dr. Trop available to
18 meet with the Minor Child(ren) and/or Petitioner before and after visits.

19 b. Respondent shall have custody of the Minor Child(ren) he designates for ten
20 hours each day from June 27, 2018 through July 1, 2018. Respondent, in his sole discretion in
21 advance, shall designate one Minor Child or two Minor Children to be with Respondent for the ten
22 hour period of time each day. On each day, Petitioner shall make arrangements and be responsible
23 for the drop off at Coworth Park Hotel of the Minor Child(ren) designated by Respondent to be with
24 Respondent for a ten hour period of time. Respondent shall return the Minor Child(ren) or cause
25 the Minor Child(ren) to be returned to Windlesham by the end of the ten hour period. Dr. Boxer
26 shall be present with the Minor Child(ren) during Respondent's time, as arranged by Respondent
27 and at Respondent's cost. Respondent shall have the discretion to have a recreational facilitator
28 present. Petitioner shall not be present during or interfere with Respondent's custodial time.

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1 Respondent shall make arrangements to have Dr. Boxer available to meet with the Minor Child(ren)
2 and/or Petitioner before and after visits.

3 c. Respondent shall have custody of the Minor Children for a four consecutive
4 day period of time between July 8, 2018 and July 14, 2018 as follows. Either:

5 i. Respondent shall designate the four day period of time. Respondent
6 shall designate in his sole discretion one, two or three of the Minor Child(ren) to be with Respondent
7 from 10:00 a.m. day one through 6:00 p.m. day two. Petitioner shall make arrangements and be
8 responsible for the drop off of the designated Minor Child(ren) at Coworth Park Hotel at 10:00 a.m.
9 day one. Respondent shall return the Minor Child(ren) or cause the Minor Child(ren) to be returned
10 to Windlesham by 6:00 p.m. on day two. Respondent shall designate in his sole discretion one, two
11 or three of the Minor Child(ren) to be with Respondent from 10:00 a.m. day three through 6:00 p.m.
12 day four. Petitioner shall make arrangements and be responsible for the drop off of the designated
13 Minor Child(ren) at Coworth Park Hotel at 10:00 a.m. day three. Respondent shall return the Minor
14 Child(ren) or cause the Minor Child(ren) to be returned to Windlesham by 6:00 p.m. on day four.
15 Respondent shall have Dr. Boxer or Dr. Trop present, and may have a recreational facilitator
16 present. Petitioner shall not be present during or interfere with Respondent's custodial time.
17 Respondent shall make arrangements to have Dr. Boxer or Dr. Trop available to meet with the Minor
18 Child(ren) and/or Petitioner before and after the two day periods.

19 ii. In the alternative, at Respondent's option, Respondent may make
20 arrangements to have the Minor Children participate in a four day program between July 8 and July
21 14, 2018 designed by Dr. Rebecca Bailey of Transitioning Families and the members of her support
22 staff, to work with Respondent and the children, and shall pay the cost of same. Respondent shall
23 provide notice to Petitioner that he is doing so and of the four day period, and Petitioner shall make
24 arrangements and be responsible for the drop off of the children at Coworth Park Hotel on the day
25 and at the time designated by Respondent. Petitioner shall not be present during four day program
26 unless requested by Dr. Bailey. Respondent shall have the discretion to determine whether the
27 children will stay overnight at his hotel or at Windlesham, and shall take into consideration Dr.
28 Bailey's recommendations in connection therewith. Respondent may also have Chris Johnson

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1 participate.

2 d. Respondent shall have custody of the Minor Children in California from July
3 21, 2018 to July 29, 2018. Petitioner shall be responsible for ensuring that the children return to
4 Los Angeles on July 21, 2018. Respondent shall be responsible for causing the children to return
5 to Petitioner in London on July 29, 2018. Respondent shall designate and pay the cost of the
6 children's transportation between London and Los Angeles, including the cost for assistants and
7 security for the children, whether they travel commercially or privately. During this period,
8 Respondent shall have the discretion to determine whether the children spend the night at
9 Respondent's residence, the former family home ("Briarcliff"), or at Petitioner's residence
10 ("DeMille") and may take them to Santa Barbara. If any of the children stay overnight at DeMille,
11 Respondent shall arrange for appropriate child care and security, at Respondent's cost, and
12 Respondent shall make arrangements to have the child or children return to Briarcliff in the morning.
13 Respondent shall have either Darren Laos or Michael Ofstedahl present, and shall have the
14 discretion to have a recreational facilitator present. Respondent shall make arrangements to have
15 Dr. Boxer and/or Dr. Trop spend some time with the Minor Children during this time period. During
16 the period that the Minor Children are in California, Petitioner may call the children no more than
17 once per day, at times agreed upon in advance by the parties.

18 5. Petitioner shall either return to Los Angeles with the Minor Children or shall cause
19 the Minor Children to return to Los Angeles on August 11, 2018. Between the time the Minor
20 Children return to Los Angeles and the orders made after the review hearing, Respondent shall have
21 custody of the Minor Children in Los Angeles as agreed upon by the parties but in no event shall
22 Respondent's time be less than four hours every other day on school days and twelve hours every
23 other day on non-school days.

24 6. The parties shall mutually agree upon a psychiatrist and a pediatrician that are
25 licensed to practice in London to treat the minor children should an emergency or illness arise.

26 7. Petitioner shall forthwith provide Respondent with each of the Minor Children's
27 personal cell phone numbers so that Respondent may text them at those numbers, and notify
28 Respondent of any new cell phone numbers. Petitioner shall not monitor the Minor Children's texts

1 messages with Respondent and shall not provide Respondent with the number of a cell phone that
2 she maintains in her possession at which to text the children.

3 8. A review hearing shall be scheduled to take place the week of August 13, 2018 or as
4 soon thereafter as possible for further interim orders pending the completion of the custody
5 evaluation.

6 9. The Court hereby provides notice to Petitioner that if the Minor Children remain
7 closed down to their father and depending on the circumstances surrounding this condition, it may
8 result in a reduction of the time that they spend with Petitioner and may result in the Court ordering
9 primary physical custody to Respondent.

10 10. The Superior Court of the State of California, County of Los Angeles, has
11 Jurisdiction to make orders over the parties and the Minor Children under the Uniform Child
12 Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act, as both parties and the Minor Children reside in the
13 County of Los Angeles and within the State of California.

14 11. Notice and opportunity to be heard were given to the parties.

15 12. A violation of this order may subject the party in violation to civil or criminal
16 penalties, or both.

17 13. The "Home State" of the Minor Children under Family Code Section 3402(g) is the
18 State of California and that the Country of "Habitual Residence" of the Minor Children for purposes
19 of the Hague Convention and International Law is the United States of America.
